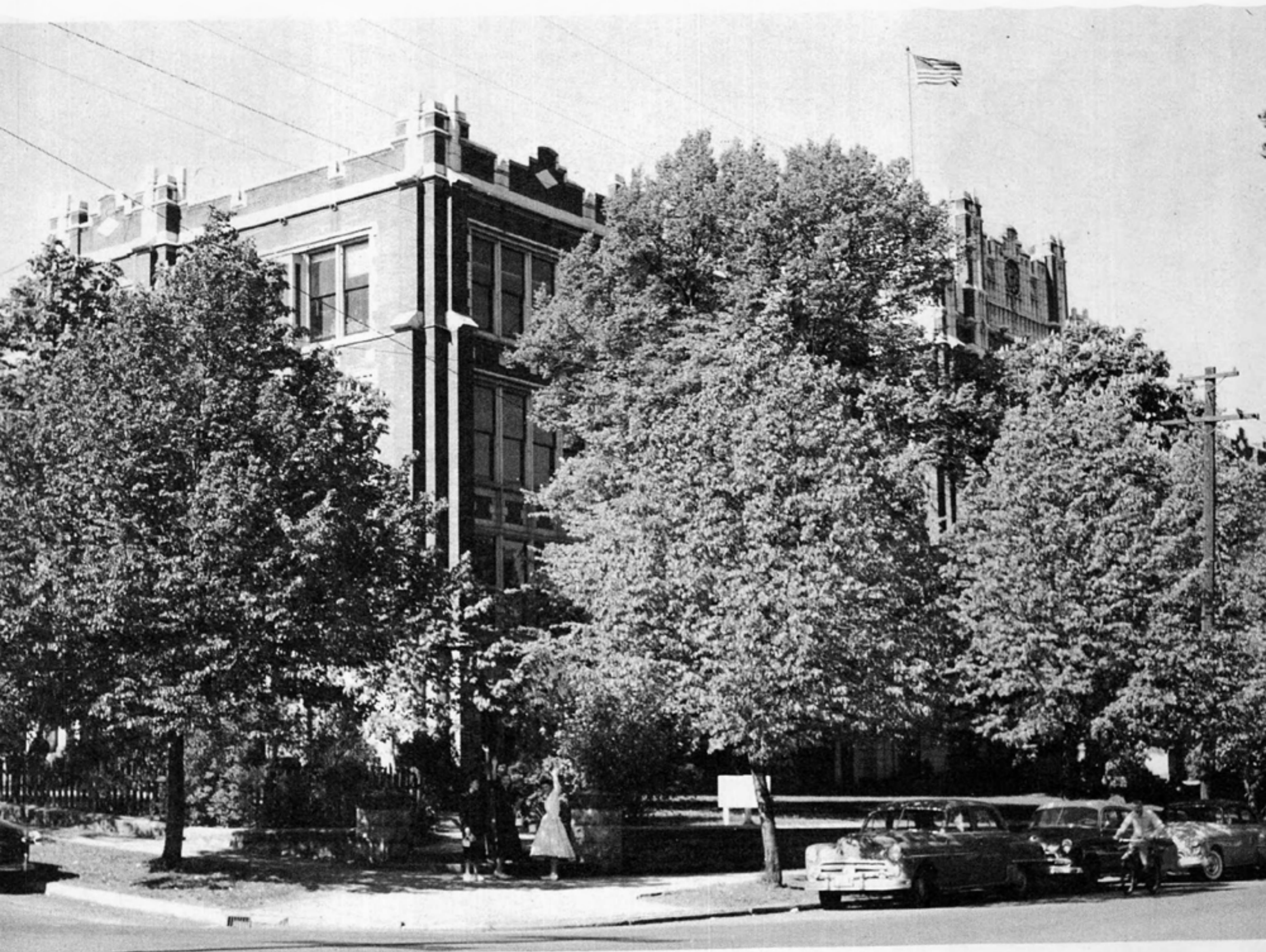


## A TIGER'S TALE

On her fine help he really dotes.*



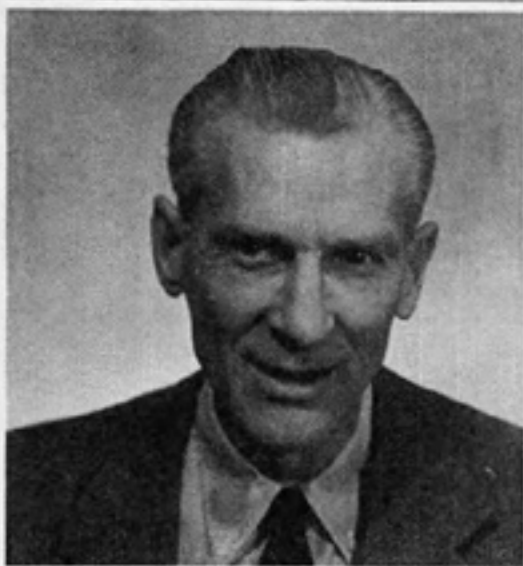

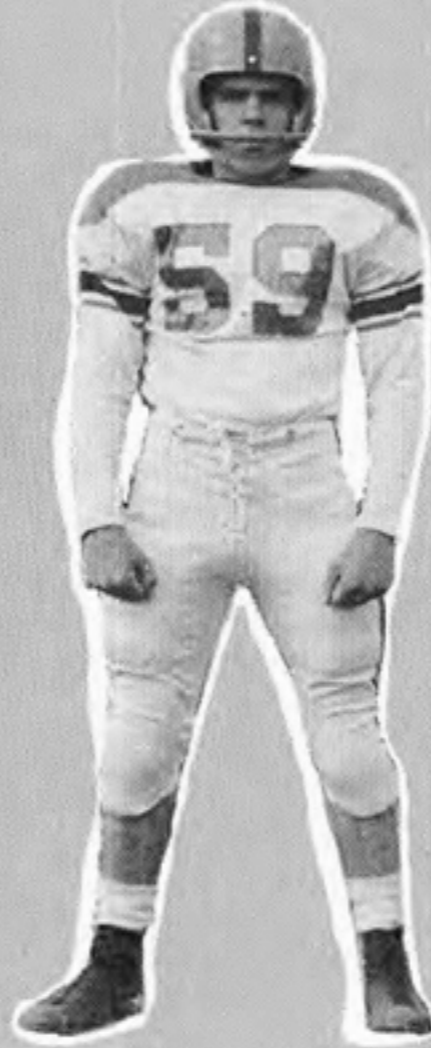

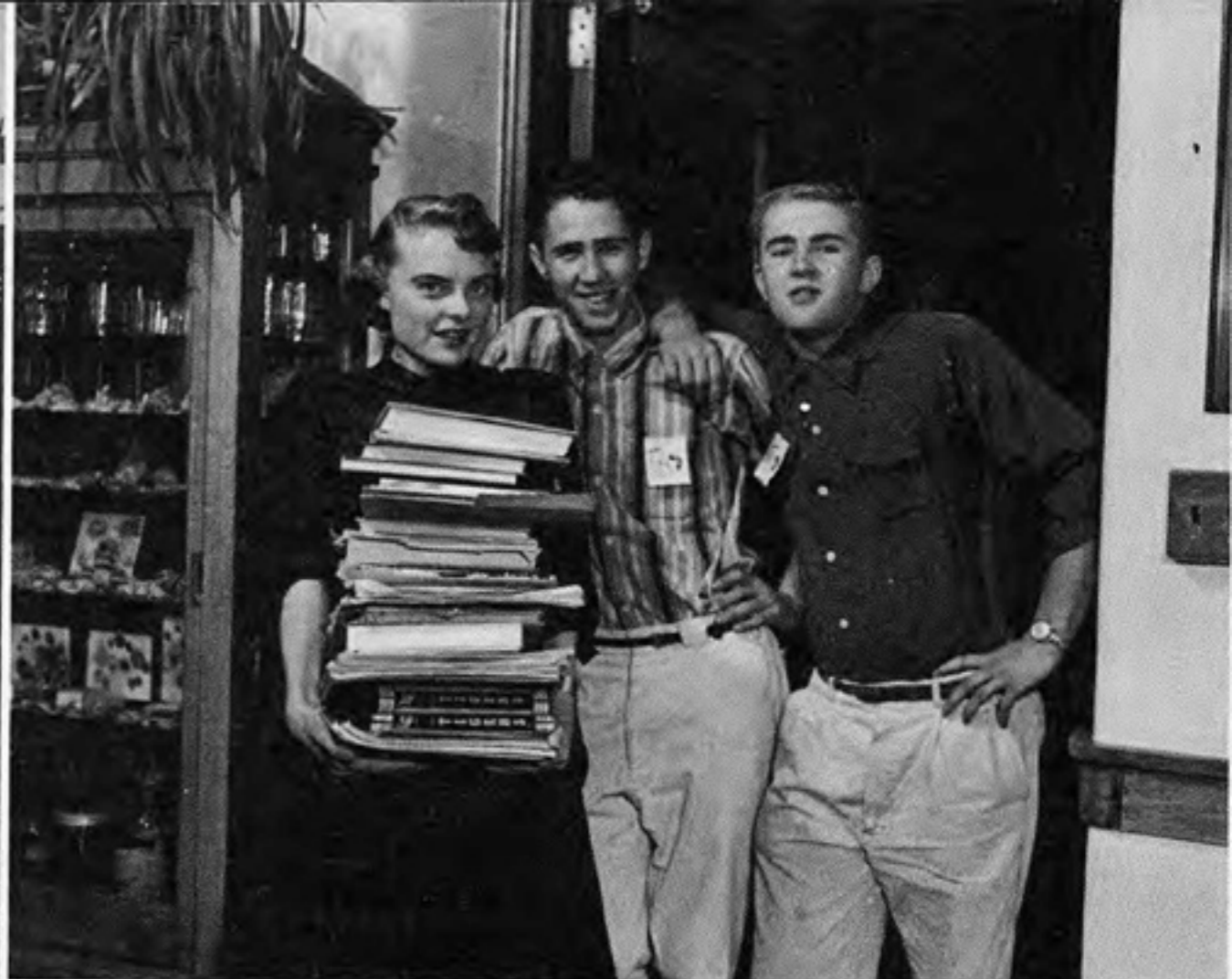

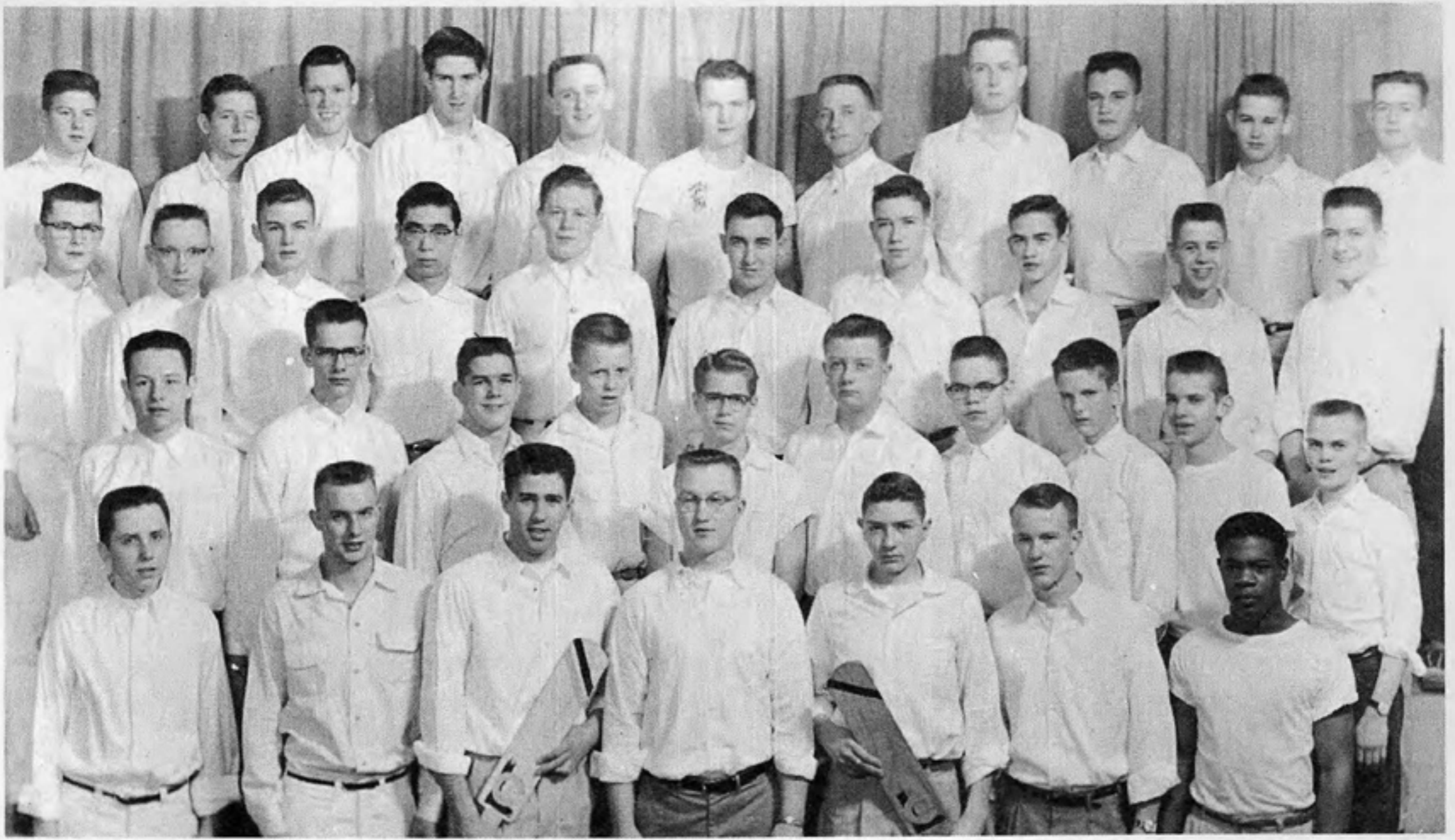
